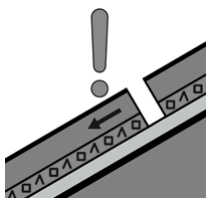


### THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 20/04/2013

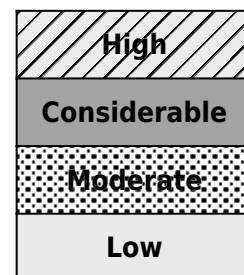
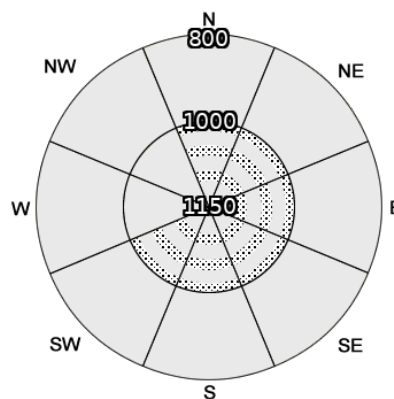
##### Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The majority of the remaining snowpack will be well bonded and stable. Localised areas of moderately bonded windslab will be found on East through South to South-West aspects above 1000 metres. Drifting of deposits will also form new accumulations in sheltered locations on North to East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Mostly dry with the occasional light snow flurry. Overnight moderate South-Westerly winds becoming strong during the day. The freezing level will rise from 900 metres overnight to 1100 metres by the afternoon.

##### Comments

Limited, patchy snow below 900m. Extensive areas on the higher hills and plateaus. Deepest on West to North aspects.
