

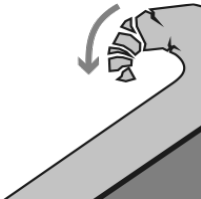

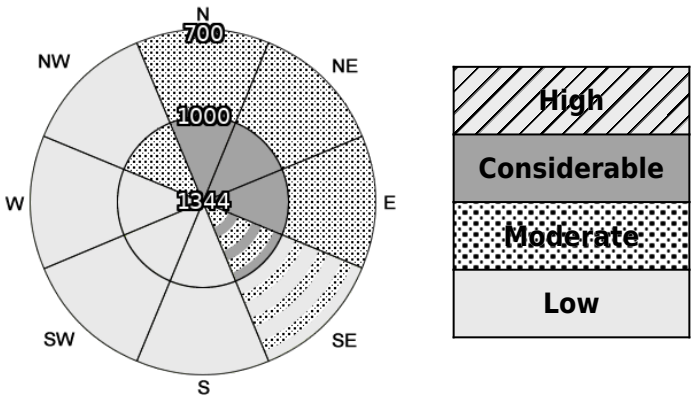
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of fresh unstable windslab will be deposited on mainly North to East aspects above 1000 metres where avalanches are likely. Some areas may also develop at lower levels later in the day. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. Windward aspects will tend to be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain will turn to snow above 900 metres overnight. By the end of the day the freezing level will have dropped to 900 metres, and snow will fall above 700 metres. Strong winds from the South-West will ease slightly.

Rock and ice fall a hazard on Saturday. More wintry conditions expected on Sunday
