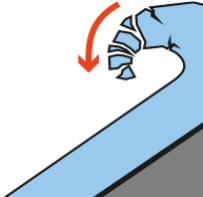

Wind Slab



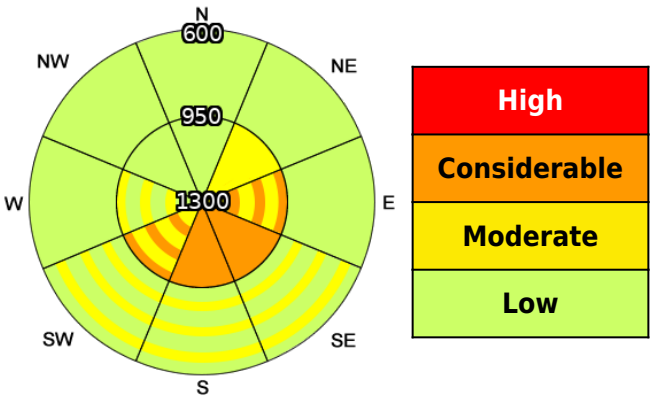

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will be present on Easterly through South to South-Westerly aspects mainly above 950 metres, with steep and convex slopes mostly affected. Elsewhere the snowpack will generally be moderate to well bonded. Fresh cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, strong Northerly winds with moderate snowfall above mainly 700 metres. During the day light snow showers are expected, winds lessening in the morning becoming West -South-Westerly, but strengthening later. Freezing level rising from 500 to 700 metres.
