Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will moisten and instabilities will develop on all steep aspects above 900 metres, with steep slopes and convex terrain most affected. Where deeper accumulations exist on mainly Northerly through East to Southerly aspects above 900 metres avalanches are likely. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-Westerly winds with sleet and light rain is expected throughout the forecast period. Freezing level 1400 metres overnight then 1600 metres during the day.
