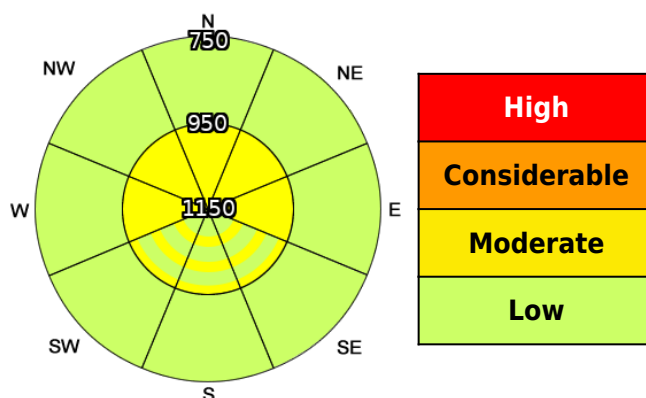


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE****Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 06/05/2013****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected to the snowpack. Wet snow instabilities will persist, mainly on the steeper slopes with a West through North to East aspect above 950 metres. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Mild conditions with heavy rain at all elevations, becoming drier towards the latter part of the day. Overnight, strong South-Westerly winds will ease during the day, becoming South-South-Westerly, summit temperatures expected to be plus 4-5 degrees Celsius.

**Comments**

During Monday the frontal band shifts North with drier but still mild weather pushing slowly Northwards very unsettled windy theme until midweek. Colder later in the week.
