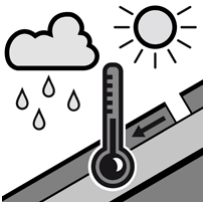


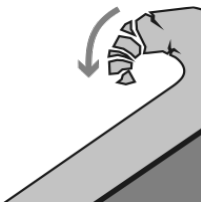

Avalanche Problems



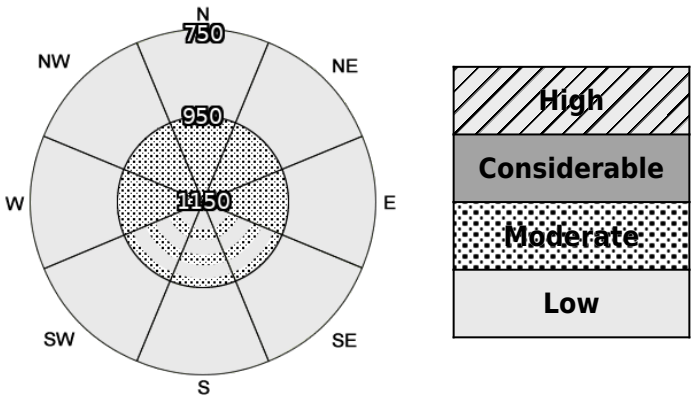
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected to the snowpack. Wet snow instabilities will persist, mainly on the steeper slopes with a West through North to East aspect above 950 metres. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mild conditions with heavy rain at all elevations, becoming drier towards the latter part of the day. Overnight, strong South-Westerly winds will ease during the day, becoming South-South-Westerly, summit temperatures expected to be plus 4-5 degrees Celsius.

Comments

During Monday the frontal band shifts North with drier but still mild weather pushing slowly Northwards very unsettled windy theme until midweek.Colder later in the week.
