There will be small isolated pockets of new wind slab instability on North-North-West through to North-East and South-South-East aspects above 800 metres on steep gully exits and corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**High****Considerable****Moderate****Low****Forecast Weather Influences**

Unsettled Westerly flow continues with gale force winds easing on during the day. There will be some snow showers above 500 metres. Winds will be from the West-South-West, backing South-West and later South-South-West. Temperatures will cool a little.

Comments

With a couple of degrees of cooling there will be some quite good climbing conditions in high snow gullies.
