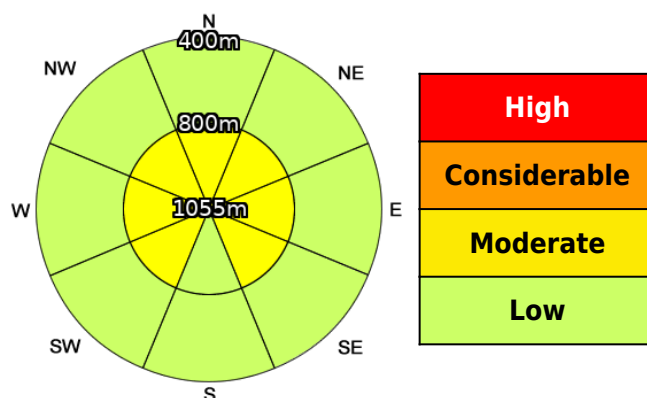
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing older snowpack will be generally stable with isolated pockets of new unstable wind slab on highest corrie rims and gully exits of nearly all aspects above 850m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers tonight will turn to rain during the day. Accumulations will be light. Winds will be highly variable by direction; mainly in the East-South-East quarter and later veering Westerly. Winds will remain strong. Temperatures will rise during the day with the freezing level about 1000m.
