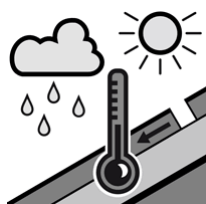

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 29/12/2013

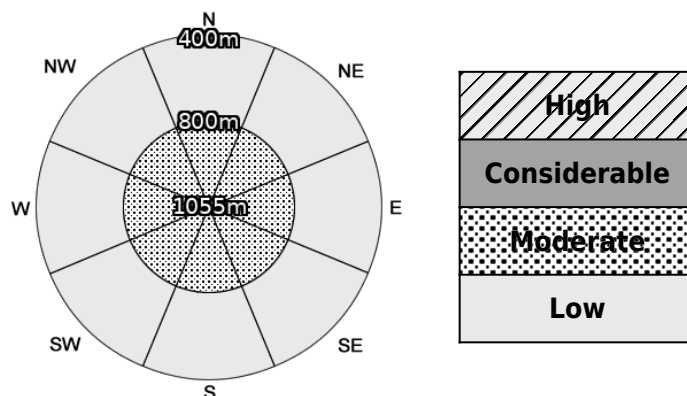
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas with deeper snow cover will be mainly well consolidated and stable. Some surface loose snow instability will persist on all very steep rocky ground. Some isolated pockets of wind slab will exist at high corrie rims above 800m on nearly all aspects dependent on exposure to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A ridge of high pressure will be briefly established through the forecast period. Winds will be highly variable in direction; West-North-West, backing through all quadrants to Southerly. There will be some snow showers above 600m, with rain below.
