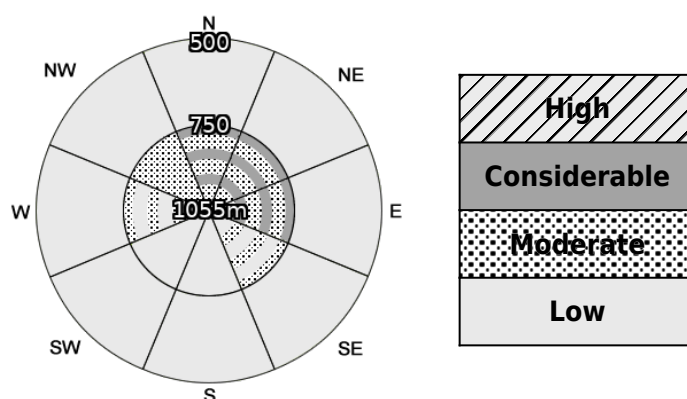


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 01/01/2014****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Some new unstable pockets of wind slab will develop on Westerly through to Northerly aspects above 800m. This slab will be mainly confined to high corrie rims and gully exits on indicated aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Showers through the region with some snow above 450m during the night. Gale force winds will be from the South-South-East at first then veering Southerly and becoming East-South-East tomorrow. Overnight temperatures will rise slightly and cool again during the afternoon.

Comments

Some ice development noted on high corrie terrain. Small loose snow avalanche deposit noted on East aspect on Beinn Bhan.
