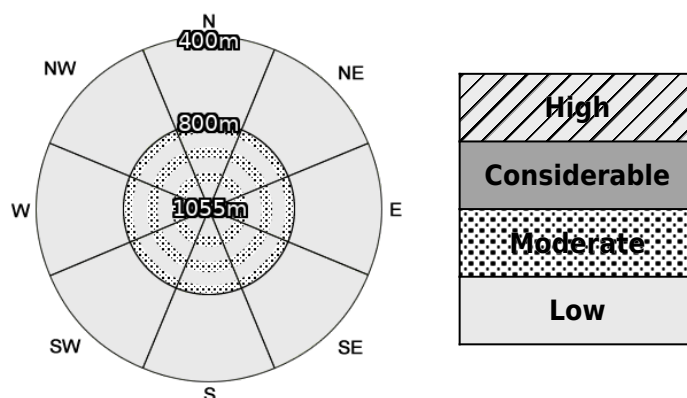

Avalanche Problems

Wind Slab
Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 800m on corrie rims and gully exits a few pockets of new moderately bonded wind slab will continue to develop. Due to cross loading and local corrie wind effects over the past few days, nearly all aspects will be affected. The distribution of this instability is not extensive downslope. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate


Forecast Weather Influences

A band of rain and scattered showers will move through the region. Wind direction will vary in Southerly quadrants from South-South-West and Southerly. Temperatures will cool a little overnight with freezing level below 1000m, rising tomorrow.

Bright moments early in day became increasingly dull as heavier showers persisted.
