

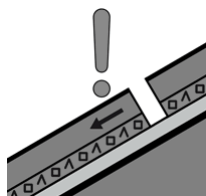

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 11/01/2014

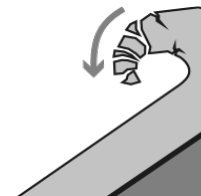

Wind Slab



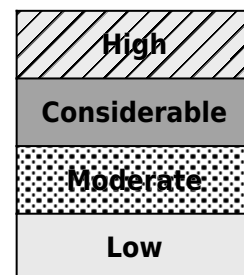
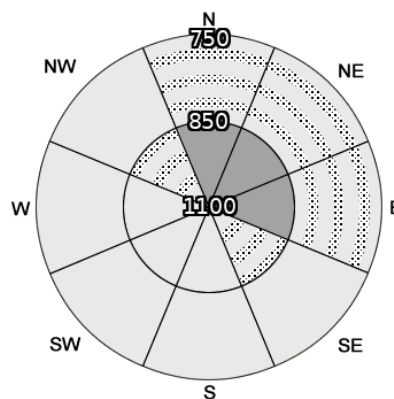
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of instability will persist and develop in high sheltered lee locations. In these areas new deposits of marginally stabilised windslab will form above 850m on North to East facing aspects especially at the top of coire backwalls and gully tops. New cornice development will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers throughout accompanied by fresh generally South-Westerly winds. The Freezing level will lower to around 600m.

Comments

Some general improvement in winter conditions although fresh winds will persist and feel very cold on the tops.
