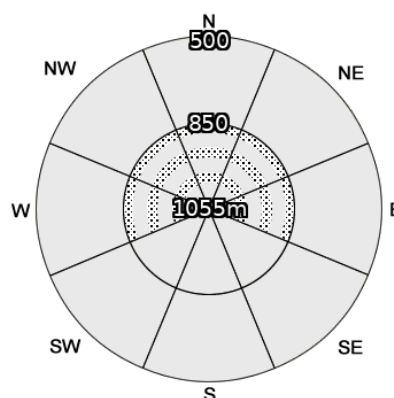

Avalanche Problems

Wind Slab

Persistent Weak Layers
Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Strengthening winds will redistribute some of the existing fresh snow onto West and North-West aspects. Localised unstable deposits will also be present on North, North-East and East aspects above 850m. Old snow on other aspects and all wind blown slopes will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.


Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with strengthening South-Easterly winds. The freezing level will rise to 900m by Sunday morning and rise further during the day.
