Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Additional layered and weakly bonded windslab will be loaded onto all steep North-West through North to East aspects above 750m. Some very steep lee slopes and gullies will be overhung by soft, weak cornices. Good stability on all recently wind exposed aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold with overnight snow showers on moderate South-East, later South-Westerly winds.

Comments

Good snow ice in lower reaches of main gullies but weak windslab and soft cornices awaits the unwary at higher altitudes.
