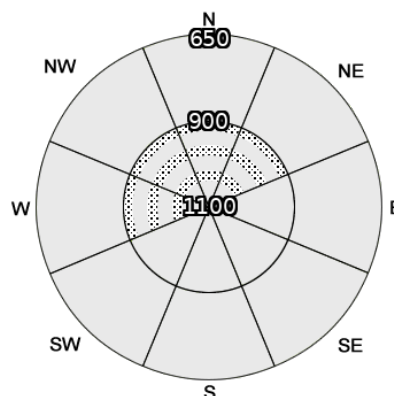
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will remain good in many locations for most of the day. Accumulations of soft moderately stabilised windslab will form later on some steep West through North to North-East aspects above 900m. Large, old cornices will remain in place above many steep coire backwalls and gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and cool overnight. Light snow showers later in the day. Winds will be light South-Easterly increasing to moderate by afternoon.

Comments

Good ski touring in our area above 650m with more or less complete plateau cover. Flattering corn-like snow below 850m on Friday.
