

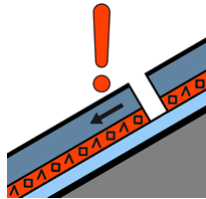

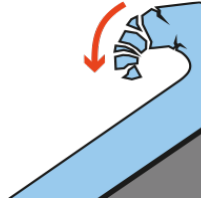

Wind Slab



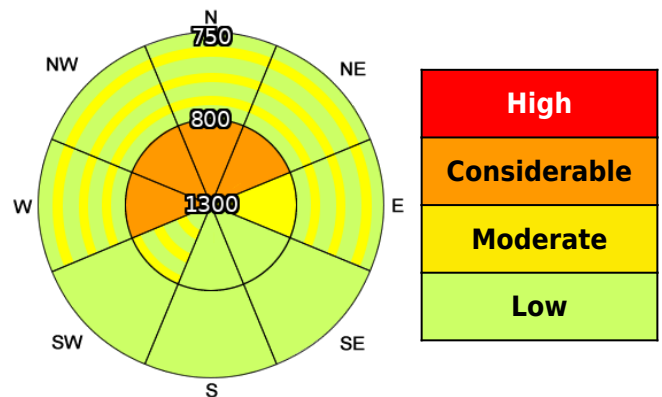
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly bonded windslab will exist on West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres. On these aspects in steep terrain avalanches are likely especially, around corrie rims, gully exits, crag aprons, and scarp slopes. Cross loading will affect other areas and cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry night with moderate South winds. During the day moderate snowfall is expected above 500 metres on strong South-East winds. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.
