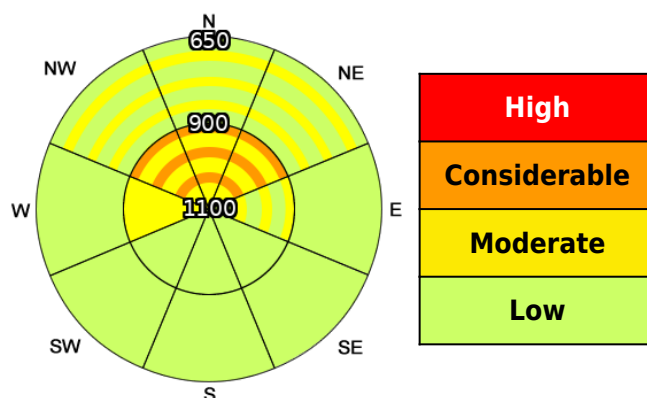

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of marginally stabilised windslab will be present on high, sheltered West through North to North-East aspects above 900m. Elsewhere the snowpack will be well consolidated and stable. Cornices will remain in many places above steep coire backwalls and gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers continuing overnight and into the early hours. Strong South-East winds will ease and become light or moderate. Less cold temperatures.
