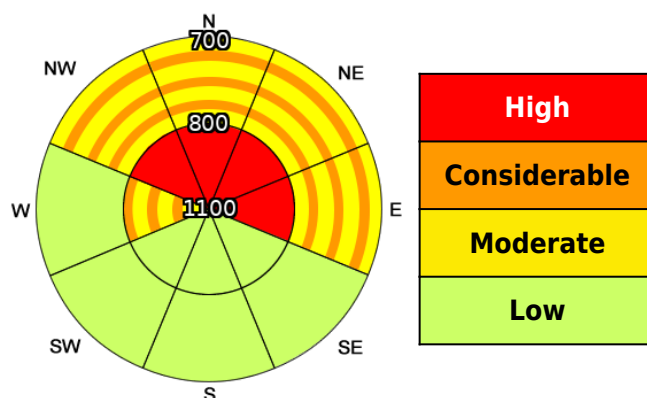

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Very poor stability overnight into Saturday with avalanche activity expected on all North-West through North to East aspects. A brief improvement in stability before new, deep and weakly stabilised windslab accumulates quickly on North West through North to East aspects above 800m. Avalanches will occur in all these locations. All cornices will be weak and prone to sudden collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High.



Forecast Weather Influences

Very mild with rain in the early evening and until the early hours followed by much cooler temperatures and persistent snow showers. Winds will be strong and generally South-Westerly.

Comments

Quite a mix of instability over the next 24hrs! Early wet slab avalanches followed dry slab avalanche activity expected during the afternoon.
