

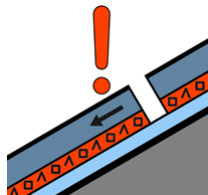

Wind Slab



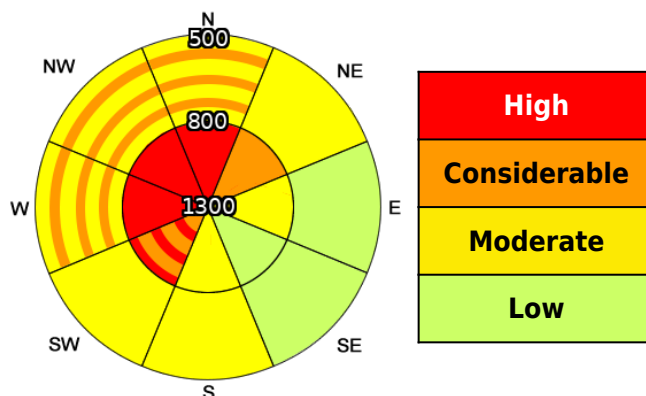
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to build on mainly South-West to Northerly aspects above 800 metres where avalanches will occur. Many other aspects will be affected with localised areas of poorly bonded windslab due to cross loading. Poor to moderately bonded accumulations will be present below this level especially in steep sheltered locations. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be strong Easterly throughout the forecast period.. Snowfall will continue through the night and throughout the day. Freezing levels will be around 600 metres then 400 metres later.

Comments

Snowfall continuing until the weekend to all levels continuing windy.
