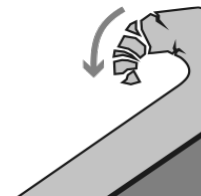

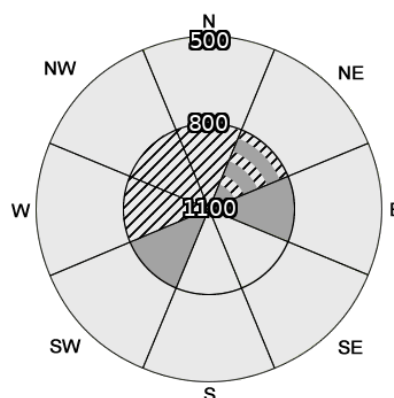

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Older windslab below 750m will continue to consolidate in all locations. Poor stability where new windslab forms on steep West to North aspects above 800m where avalanches will occur. Lingering localised instability also in some sheltered North-East and East facing gullies above the same altitude. All new cornices will be soft and prone to sudden collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers continuing overnight and for the first part of the day. Becoming colder with moderate East or South East winds.
