

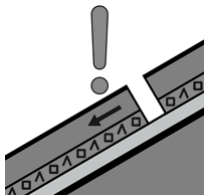

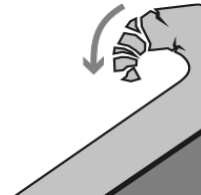

Wind Slab



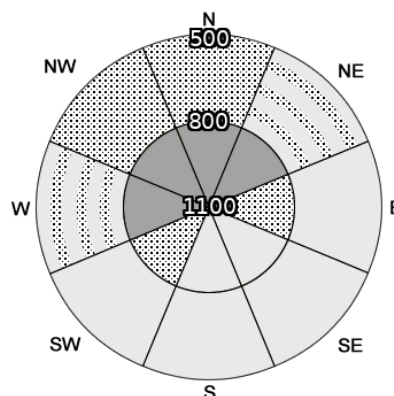
Persistent Weak Layers



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Very poor stability on all West through North to North-East aspects above 800m where avalanches are likely. All new cornices above these locations will be weak and prone to sudden collapse. Much better stability on exposed ridges and recently wind scoured slopes and gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Spells of snowfall throughout the period on strong mainly Southerly winds. Remaining cold.

Comments

Persistent buried weak layer now showing up in field tests and contributing to more widespread instability. Little or no immediate improvement in overall mountain conditions expected on Saturday.
