

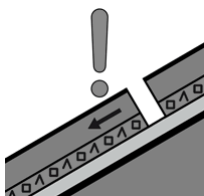

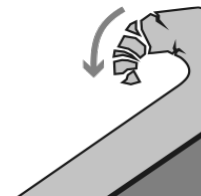

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will continue to accumulate in any locations sheltered from the wind. The tops of gullies and corrie rims of North to East aspects above 750m will be most affected. Cornices will continue to develop and may be unstable in the brief warming spell. Aspects exposed to the wind will be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-Westerly winds with frequent snow showers throughout the forecast period. The freezing level will briefly rise towards the summits on Sunday morning before dropping again as the day progresses.
