

Wind Slab





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowfall, and wind redistribution of the existing snowpack will deposit areas of poorly bonded windslab on West to North aspects above 700 metres where avalanches are likely. North-East and East aspects will remain affected by existing accumulations of moderately bonded windslab. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be snow showers through the forecast period. Moderate to strong winds will be from the South-East. The freezing level will drop to 300m overnight and generally be around 600 metres through the day.
