

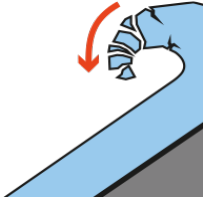

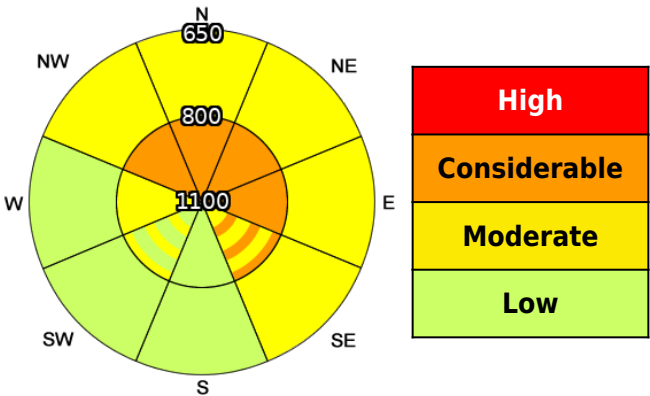
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some initial consolidation of snow is possible in all locations overnight but stability will decline quickly when drifting commences as wind speeds increase. Weak, poorly stabilised windslab will be present on all North West through North to East aspects above 800m where avalanches are likely. Large cornices will continue to threaten to collapse on to very steep lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers dying out overnight with much lighter winds. Winds then increasing during the early hours and becoming strong South Easterly, later South Westerly. Snow showers commencing again after dawn, becoming heavier later. Much colder temperatures.

Comments

Significant objective danger from avalanches and collapsing cornices on most steep lee slopes. Careful route choice required.
