

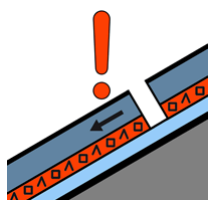

**Wind Slab**



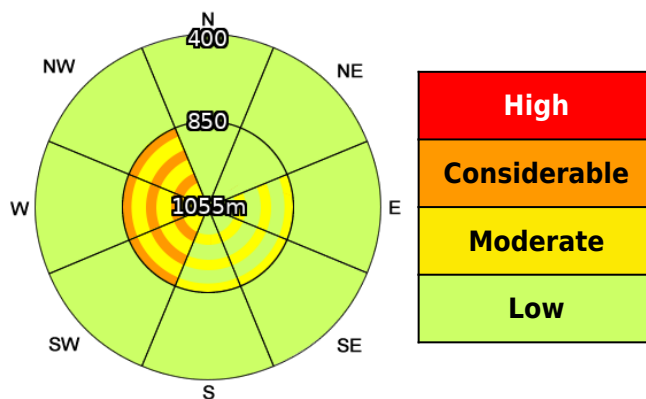

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be poorly bonded windslab being deposited onto sheltered South-West, West and North-West slopes above 850m. These deposits will be greatest on corrie rims and gully exits. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Moderate Easterly wind during the day as a weak front approaches. There will be little precipitation and the freezing level will remain below the summits.
