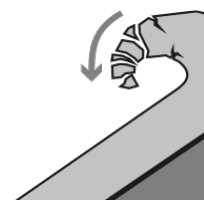
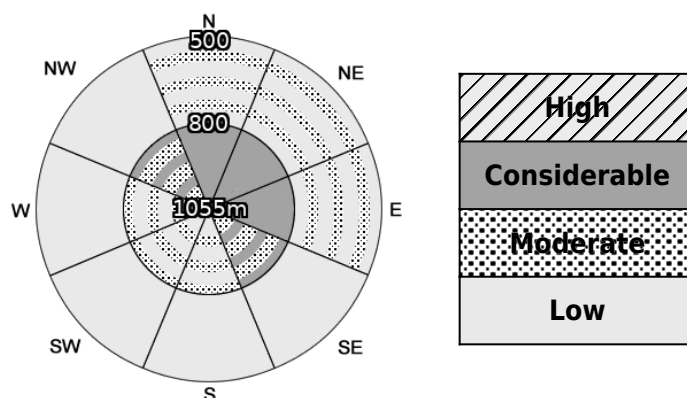

Wind Slab

Cornices
Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will continue to build in sheltered locations on North to East facing aspects above 800m with the tops of gullies and corrie rims being particularly affected. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. Cross loading will affect other aspects. Good stability on wind exposed ridges. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.


Forecast Weather Influences

The weather will remain very unsettled. Gale force winds from a South-Westerly direction and frequent heavy showers falling as snow above 600m. The freezing level will remain around 800m.
