

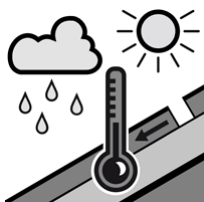

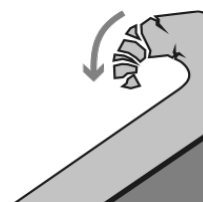

Wind Slab



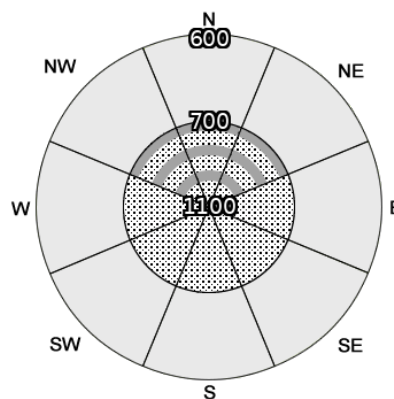

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will show better stability in most locations as temperatures fall though there will be potential for full depth avalanches on very steep ground below 700m. New localised, moderately bonded accumulations of windslab will form mainly on North West to North East aspects above 900m. Better stability in most other locations. Some new cornice development expected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Some snow showers throughout the period. Becoming progressively colder with strong South East winds.
