

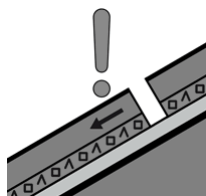

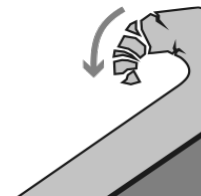

Wind Slab



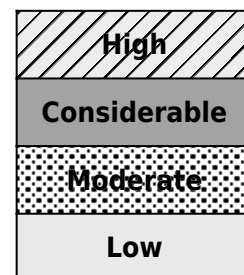
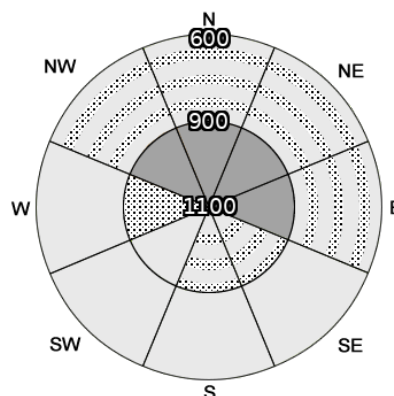
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will remain good on all wind scoured aspects and exposed ridges. Snow below 800m in most locations will continue to consolidate. Deep marginally stabilised windslab will be present on North-West through North to East aspects above 900m where avalanches are likely. Very large cornices will continue to threaten many steep lee slopes, crags and gullies with sudden collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers overnight and in early morning then again later in the afternoon. Remaining cold with moderate to strong South Easterly or South Westerly winds.
