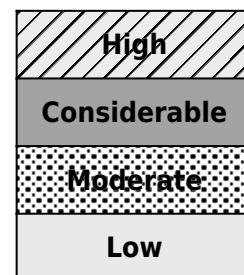
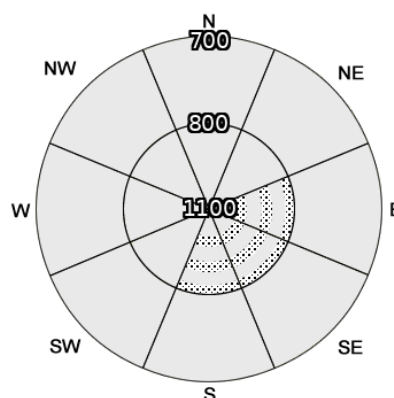
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Colder conditions overnight will help consolidate the old snowpack in all locations. Some localised wet snow instabilities in warm daytime temperatures will affect all sun exposed slopes. Good stability on wind scoured aspects. Old large cornices lines remain questionable and should be treated with caution. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry and settled with overnight freezing level of 700m rising to above summits during the day. Winds will be generally light South Westerly.

Comments

Cover is still looking good on the tops , best on the Sron a Ghoire side of the range with slopes off Cairn Liath now very patchy below 800m.
