

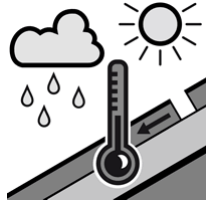

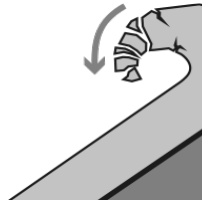
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



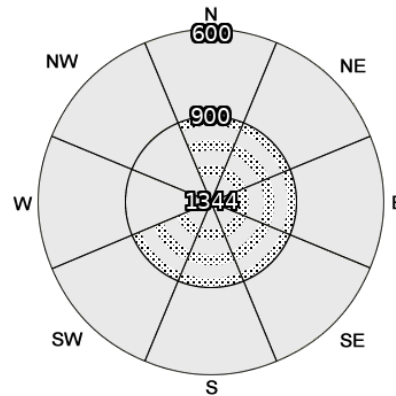
Wet Snow



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised instabilities will be present around many corrie rims and steep slopes exposed to solar radiation. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally stable. Cornices will remain unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to moderate South-Westerly winds over the summits. No precipitation is expected. The freezing level will be above the summits.

Comments

Please Note: Cornice collapse is independent of avalanche hazard. There are some very large unstable cornices above many slopes. These are prone to unexpected collapse and may trigger avalanches from the slopes below. Long debris run-outs are likely.
