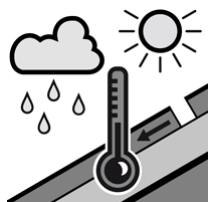


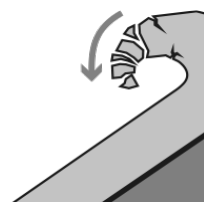

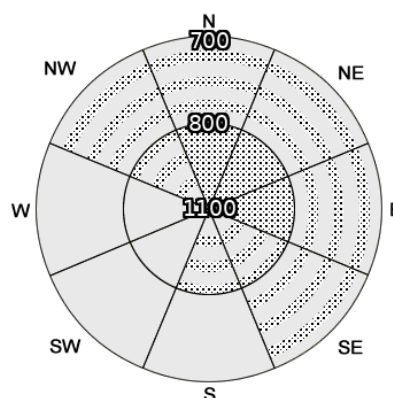

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and remain moderately well stabilized in most locations and altitudes. Potential for full depth avalanches as glide cracks will continue to widen on selected steep East to South-East aspects. Collapse-prone cornices will continue to threaten many North-West through North to South-East facing coire backwalls and gullies with high potential loading; runouts may be long. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining mild at all altitudes with persistent light rainfall. Very strong Westerly winds.

Comments

Staying mild throughout. Projected summit temperature reaching +3 degrees C. at around midday on Sunday. Snow cover best above 750m.
