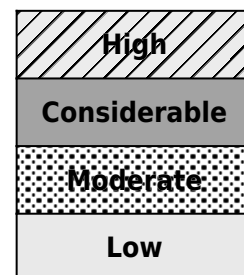
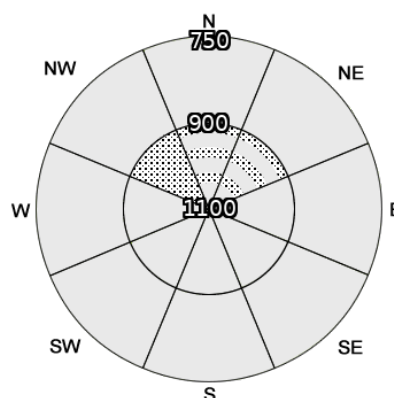
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some wet snow instability is possible on North-West through North to North-East aspects above 900m, though stability will remain generally good in most other locations. All cornices will become weaker in the mild conditions. Glide cracks will continue to widen on selected very steep East and South-East aspects below 850m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. It will remain generally mild with easing East-South-Easterly winds.

Comments

Mad March weather on Saturday with unexpected overnight snowfall up high and rain at lower levels. Cornice collapse still a consideration in projected milder weather.
