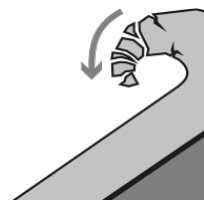

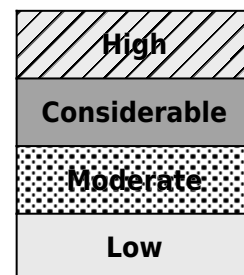
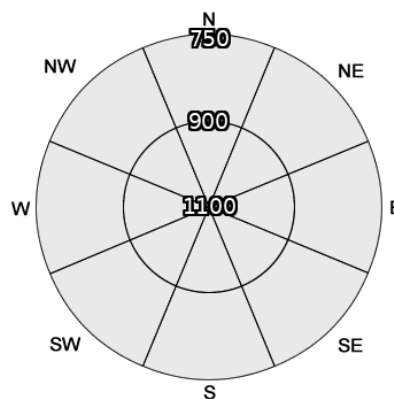
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little significant change. The snowpack will stay generally well consolidated and stability will be good in most locations. Later the cooler conditions will slow the thaw rate, development of various glide cracks at slope convexities will continue, these on mostly steep East to South East aspects. In thaw conditions existing cornices will remain a threat. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

An active cold front will bring cooler air with showers turning to sleet around summits towards the end of the day. Winds will be fresh to moderate and generally Southerly
