

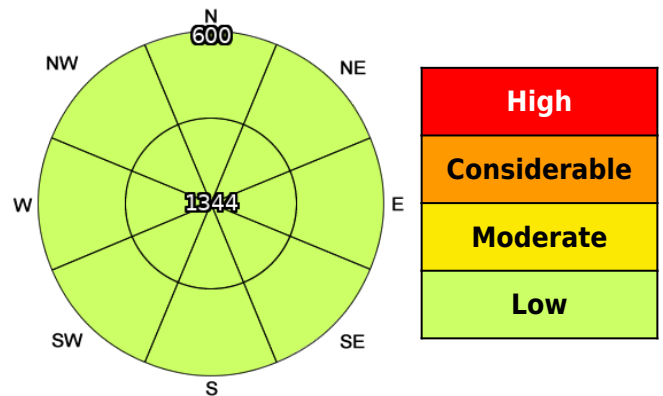

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 07/04/2014

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at most levels. On the highest summits it will begin to freeze up in the cooler conditions. Stability will generally be good at all levels. Any fresh deposits are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

It will cool down with the freezing level dropping to around summit level overnight, where it will remain throughout the day. South-Westerly winds will ease. A few showers later in the afternoon will fall as snow above about 1000 metres.

Comments

A return to slightly cooler conditions expected.
