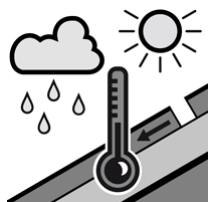


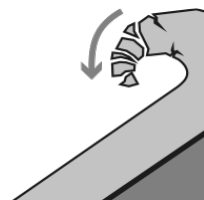

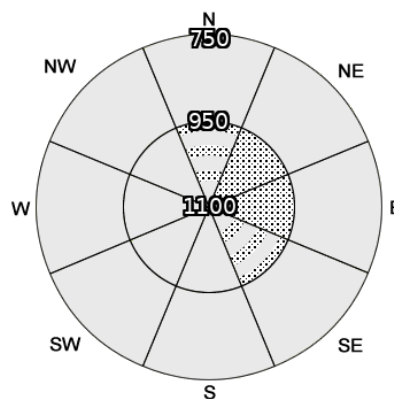
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will remain good in most locations. Wet snow instability is possible mainly on steepest North East to East aspects above 950m as snow turns to rain. Glide cracks will continue to widen in the sustained thaw. Collapsing cornices and rockfall will be additional potential hazards. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming much milder overnight with snow turning to rain at all levels and remaining wet for the rest of the day. Winds will be strong Westerly.
