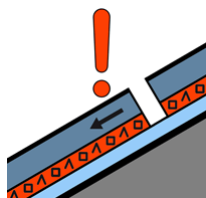
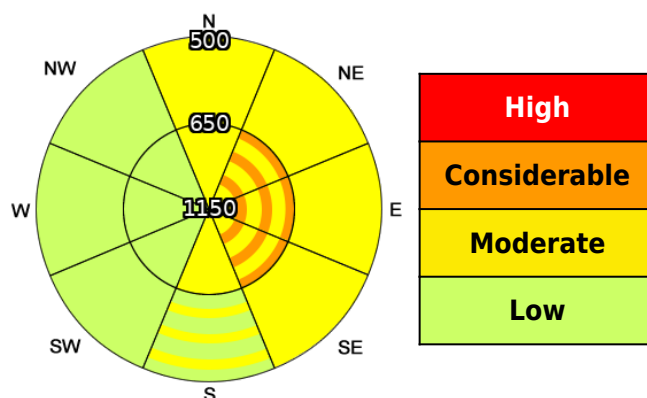


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 12/12/2014****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Persistent Weak Layers****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be deeper accumulations above valley level with areas of poor to weakly bonded windslab found in sheltered locations mostly on North-East to South-East aspects above 650 metres with other aspects affected due to cross loading. Elsewhere stability remains good on aspects exposed to the winds. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Remaining cold with some very light snowfall. Winds will be strong and veer from the West-South-West to the North-West.
