

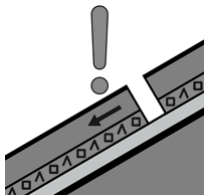

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 12/12/2014

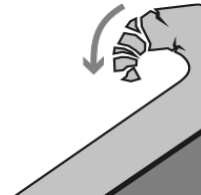
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



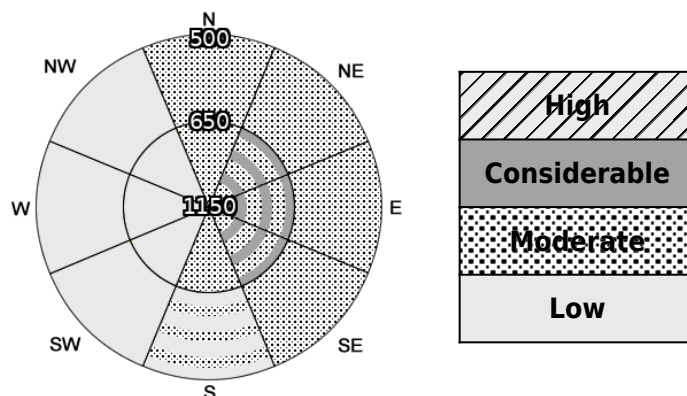
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be deeper accumulations above valley level with areas of poor to weakly bonded windslab found in sheltered locations mostly on North-East to South-East aspects above 650 metres with other aspects affected due to cross loading. Elsewhere stability remains good on aspects exposed to the winds. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold with some very light snowfall. Winds will be strong and veer from the West-South-West to the North-West.

Many areas scoured by the winds. Deep snow in sheltered locations.
