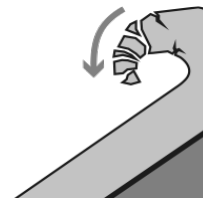

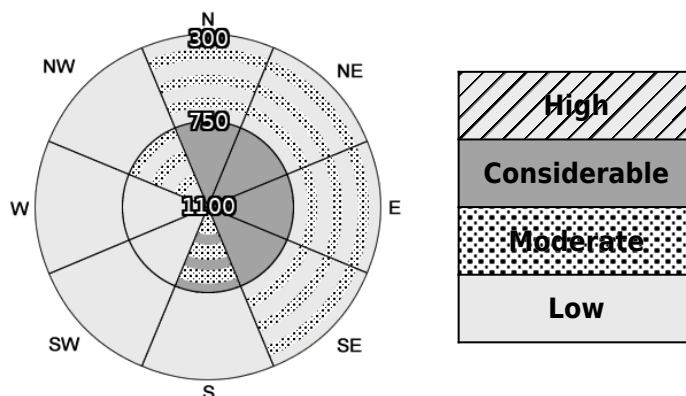

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weak windslab will continue to form mainly on steep North through East to South East aspects above 750m where avalanches are likely. Best stability will be on recently wind scoured slopes and exposed ridge lines. Soft, weak cornice development expected to continue. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold with much lighter snow showers. Winds will be moderate to strong North Westerly later South Westerly.

Comments

Less snowfall forecast but drifting expected to continue. Very wintry again on Friday with hard going pretty much everywhere. Access expected to improve as snow showers ease.
