

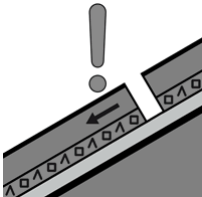

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 13/12/2014

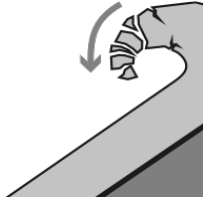

Wind Slab



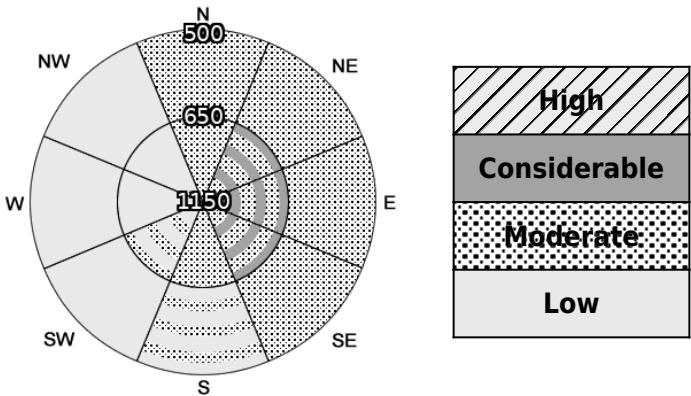
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of windslab will persist particularly on sheltered steeper terrain such as gully exits and scarp slopes on North-East through East to Southerly aspects above 650 metres with other aspects also affected by cross loading. Deep accumulations will also be found above around 500 metres on North through East to South aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be some snow overnight at most levels but the day will be largely clear. Winds will remain strong initially from the North-West but backing during the day to the South-West. Freezing level around 300 metres.

Comments

Winds easing slightly during the day but drifting snow likely to remain a significant factor.
