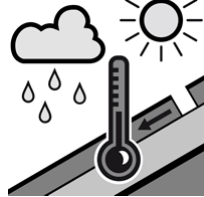

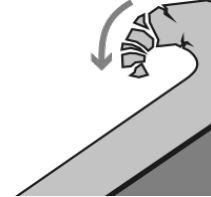

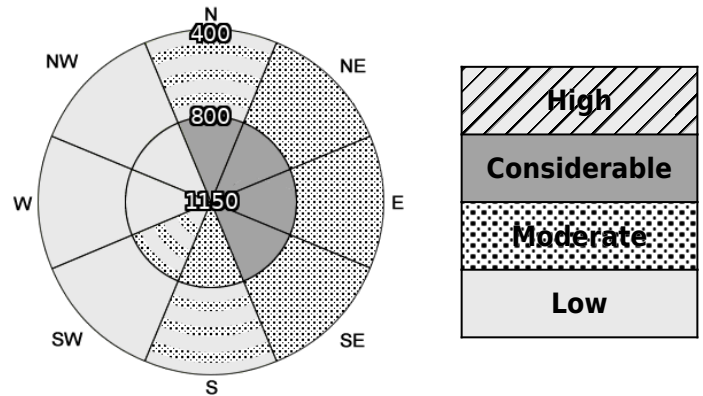

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further accumulations of unstable windslab will be deposited on North through East to South East aspects above 800 metres. This windslab will become increasingly unstable as the temperature rises. Avalanches are likely during this period. The snowpack will start to consolidate later on Sunday when the temperature falls. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Showers falling increasingly as rain at all levels overnight, heavy by Sunday morning then easing and becoming light snow showers later in the day. Gale force Westerly winds. The freezing level will rise above the summits overnight before becoming colder on Sunday.

Comments

Some consolidation of snowpack as temperature falls through Sunday.
