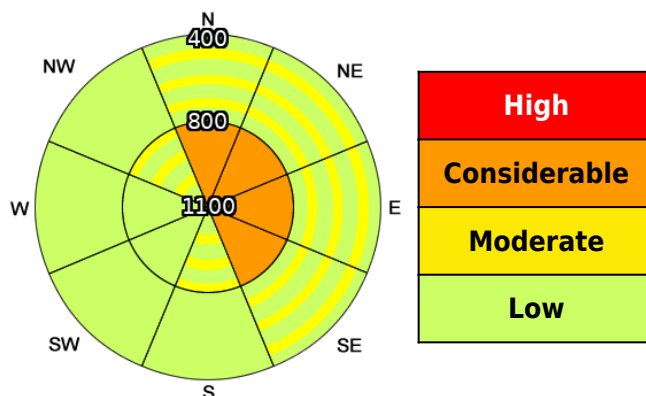

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Marginally stabilised windslab will continue to form in the stormy conditions as cold weather brings fresh deposits to steep mainly North through East to South East aspects above 800m, with some cross loading on other aspects of steep gully flanks in sheltered lee locations, where avalanches are likely. Best stability will be on recently wind scoured slopes and exposed ridge lines. Cornice development is expected to continue. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

A cold airflow will bring frequent snow showers overnight and during the day above 400m. Winds mostly West and North Westerly will be strong to gale force throughout
