

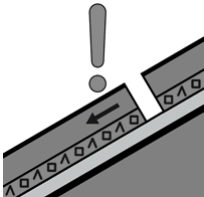

Wind Slab



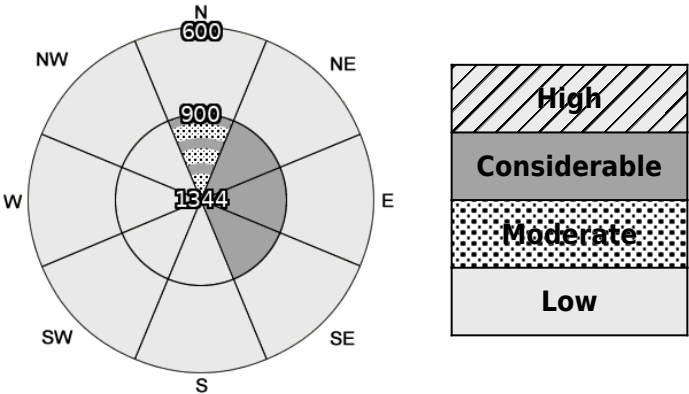
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be some consolidation of the existing snowpack. Areas of fresh unstable windslab will form on North East to South East facing slopes and other sheltered areas above 800 metres. Cornices will continue to build. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will be Westerly, gale to severe gale force. Frequent heavy showers will fall as snow at all levels. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.

Comments

Brief thaw has stripped away some snow and raised the snow level but now a return to cold wintry conditions.
