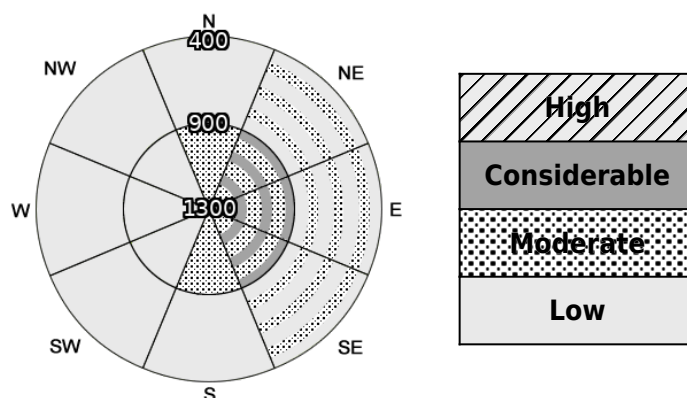
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly bonded windslab accumulations will continue to develop in lee areas. Areas most affected will be on North-East to South-East aspects mainly around Corrie rims, gully tops and crag aprons above 900 metres. Localised deposits will lie on other aspects due to cross loading. Elsewhere the old snowpack will be firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers overnight will die out to leave a dry day. Winds will be Westerly. The freezing level will be around 500 metres before steadily rising later in the afternoon.
