

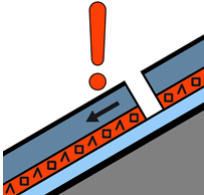

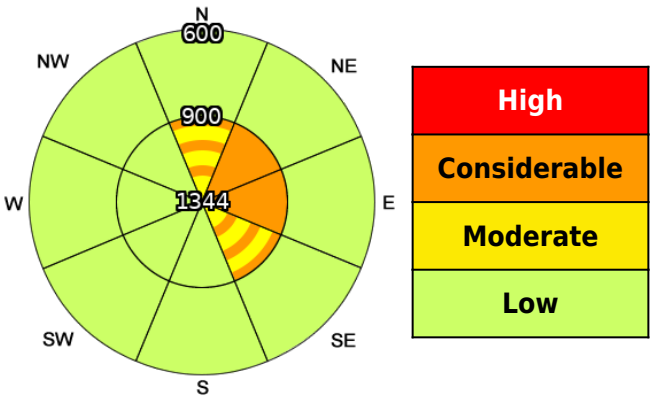
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing wet snowpack will continue to thaw then refreeze during the day. Fresh areas of unstable windslab will also form during the day. Greatest accumulations will be on sheltered North-East and East aspects above 900m. Accumulations will also be present in other sheltered locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain at or above the summits overnight before lowering during Thursday. Light overnight rain will be followed by snow showers above 600m during the day. Winds will be moderate from the West South West.
