

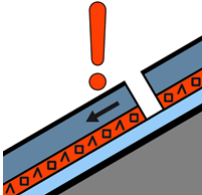

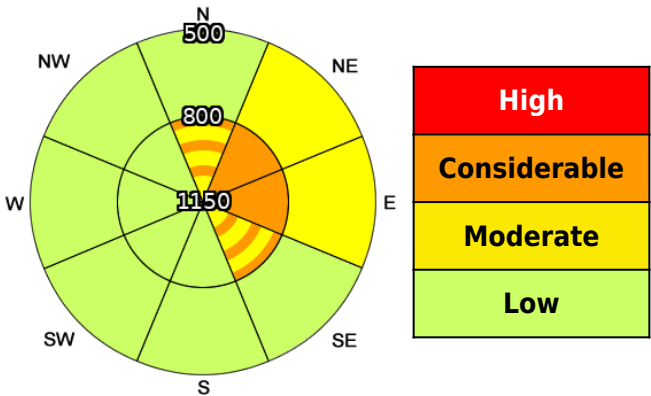
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will freeze and become firmer in the colder conditions. Throughout the period areas of unstable windslab will be form on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Sheltered locations on other aspects will be affected by cross-loading. However, exposed windward aspects will be scoured and generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to turn significantly colder with a freezing level of around 600 metres. There will be snow showers throughout the period. Strong winds will be from the West.

Comments

A return to more wintry weather forecast for Friday and Saturday. Another significant thaw expected for Sunday.
