

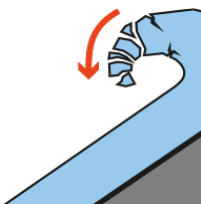

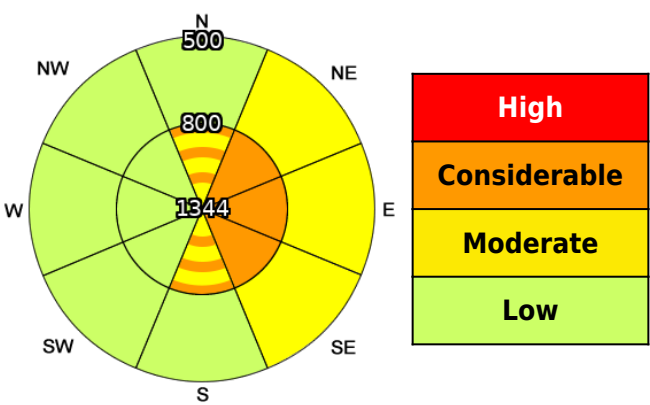
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a period of instability overnight when the snowpack becomes saturated. Through the day the wet snowpack will consolidate slightly. However, wet snow instabilities will remain on mainly steep North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will rise well above the summits where it will remain through the day. After a little snow at first, the heavy and persistent rain will fall at all level through the period. Strong winds will be from the South-West.
