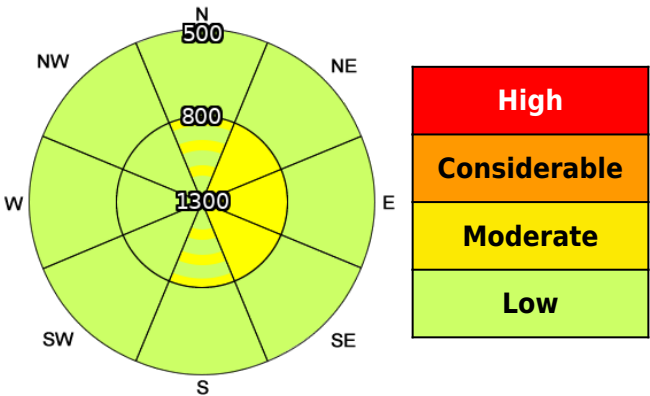
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some localised instabilities will exist in areas of steep terrain on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres; however the old snowpack will gradually stabilise in the cooler temperatures. Localised accumulations of windslab will develop on North-East and East aspects mainly around corrie rims and gully tops. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain will continue into the night before cooler temperatures arrive. Some light snowfall is then expected followed by a dry day. Strong winds will be West-South-Westerly. The freezing level will gradually fall to 200 metres by the end of the day.
