
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface of the old snowpack will refreeze above around 650 metres. Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected above 500 metres, becoming less frequent during the day. Winds will be strong mainly West-South-Westerly, easing during the day. The freezing level will be around 650 metres.
