

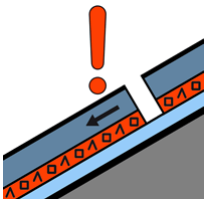

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 25/12/2014

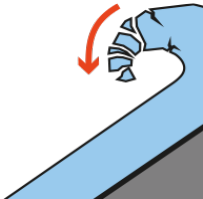
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



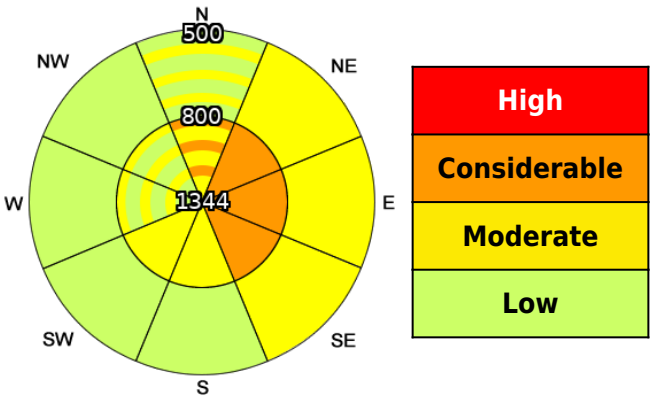
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to be deposited through the evening. Greatest accumulations will be on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Fresh cornices will be fragile. Later there will be some re-distribution of snow, leading to fresh windslab forming on other aspects, mainly South-East to South-Westerly. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Westerly winds and heavy showers falling as snow above 600 metres during the evening. After midnight the wind decreases, veers to mainly North-North-Easterly, becoming mostly dry. Freezing level around 600 metres.
