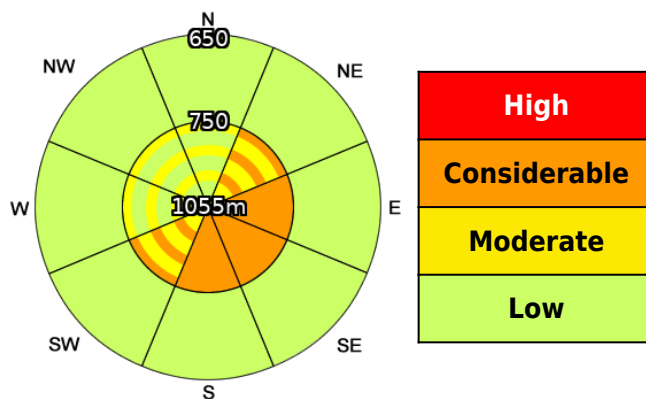
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable wind slab will form in sheltered locations, mainly on North-East to South aspects above 750 meters with other aspects being affected due to cross loading. As the wind changes direction the snow will gradually be redistributed onto West to North aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Initially there will be snow showers on strong North - West winds, by morning winds will have moderated as they veer through North and East and to South - East later in the day. Predominantly dry and clear with a freezing level around 700 meters.
